



The Philip Young Founders Trophy

A trophy to be held for one year and the entry fees for the winning driver to two Endurance Road Rally Championship events of the driver's choice during the subsequent year.

RULES

1 - The prize will be awarded to a driver who registers for the championship for the first time in that year and is in the Novice or Semi Expert category as defined by ASR 5.2 to 5.4.

2 - The winner will be the driver who has gained the most points during the year from among qualifying drivers allocated in accordance with ASRs 6.1, 6.2 & 8.2. Contenders will drop their lowest score if there are 6 or fewer rounds or their 2 lowest scores if there are 7 or more rounds. For the avoidance of doubt, if a contender does not enter an event, this counts as a zero score for the purpose of this regulation.

3 - A driver must start at least 2 events in the championship with a non expert navigator to qualify for this award (ASR 7.3)

5 - Points gained as an organiser under ASR 6.3 will be counted as a zero score for the purpose of this award.

6 - Any points gained with an Expert navigator (whether registered for the championship or not) as defined in ASR 5.2 will be counted as a zero score for the purpose of this award.

7 - In 1 above, 'The Championship' means the Endurance Road Rally Championship as run from 2009 inclusive.

8 - There can be no 'cash alternative' to this prize, and the prize will be forfeited if not taken up during the relevant year. The entry fees are non transferrable and only available to the winning driver.

9 - The fees will be paid by the ERRRC direct to the organising club at the time the driver's entry is submitted.
