



BULLETIN – 09.01.13

It has come to the notice of the Championship committee that on events with a very large selective mileage, tyre wear can be a problem. For the safety of crews and to prevent a risk of cars running with illegal tyres on the road, it has been decided to modify regulation 13.1 and add a new regulation 13.2. This will allow organisers running long events to make arrangements so that competitors may deposit up to two additional wheels/tyres with them for issue at a specified point during the event.

The revised regulations are shown below:-

13 SERVICING

13.1 Irrespective of individual event regulations pre-arranged servicing, support, tyre dumps or “chase cars” are all expressly prohibited for Championship entrants **other than as covered in 13.2 below**. Competitors may work on their own vehicle using tools and parts carried in the competing vehicle throughout the event, or borrowed from fellow competitors and also carried in their competing vehicle. They may also take advantage of any nominated support crews arranged by the organisers of the event. In emergency, parts or tyres may be repaired and/or replaced at any commercial premises en route PROVIDED this is not pre-arranged and any replacement tyres are of standard road pattern. This action must be reported to the Chief Scrutineer at the end of that leg. Any competitor not complying with this clause (and the spirit of it) will forfeit points for that event and be reported to the Championship Stewards. Further penalties may then be imposed.

13.2 Notwithstanding the above, where an event has more than 100 miles of special tests, the organisers may (with the agreement of the Championship Committee) for reasons of ensuring safety, make available facilities for competitors to deposit additional tyres at a single specified point on the event (e.g. a particular rest halt). Competitors may only access these tyres at the specified point and may leave used/damaged tyres at that point for collection at the end of the event. Organisers may make a charge for this service.
