CLASSES for 2014

Please note the classes and qualifications when completing registration.

Below is an extract from the 2014 regulations

5 CLASSES

5.1. The championship classes will be as follows

1. Experts in petrol and forced induction diesel cars 1301 - 1400cc
2. Experts in petrol and forced induction diesel cars 1001 - 1300cc
3. Experts in petrol and forced induction diesel cars up to 1000cc and other diesel cars up to 2000cc
4. Semi-Experts in petrol and forced induction diesel cars 1301 - 1400cc
5. Semi-Experts in petrol and forced induction diesel cars 1001 - 1300cc
6. Semi-Experts in petrol and forced induction diesel cars up to 1000cc and other diesel cars up to 2000cc
7. Novices in petrol and forced induction diesel cars up to 1400cc and other diesel cars up to 2000cc

5.2. Expert – A driver or navigator who, at the time of registration, has finished in the top 3 of any Endurance Road Rally or at least 3 times in the top 5 of any National B rally or has held a National A or above competition licence. Competitors who are experts in another relevant category of motor sport may also be considered experts. If you think you may fall into this category, please discuss it with the Championship co-ordinator.

5.3. Semi-Expert – A driver or navigator who, at the time of registration, falls outside the definition of Expert or Novice

5.4. Novice – A driver or Navigator who, at the time of registration, has competed on no more than 5 National B Rallies. This class is intended for people new to motorsport. If you have experience in other forms of motorsport you should discuss this with the Championship co-ordinator at the time of registration.

5.5. Checks on past results will be made to ensure competitors are registered in the correct class. The Championship Committee reserves the right to re classify any contender it believes to be in the wrong class.

5.6. Whilst classes in individual events may vary from event to event, points will be allocated on the basis of championship classes and not event classes. Contenders will remain in the same experience classification for the season regardless of results after registration. However on each event registered crew members will only gain points in the class of the most expert member of the crew. A novice therefore sharing a vehicle with an expert will be allocated points in the expert category for that event. This rule still applies if the other member of the crew is not registered for the Championship.
