

**SUMMER CHALLENGE
REGULATIONS 2012**

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REGULATIONS

The Summer Challenge, promoted by the Salisbury and Shaftesbury Car Club will run throughout 2012 on designated National B status Championship events. The Championship will cater for individuals competing in cars complying with the MSA Technical Regulations for Endurance Road Rally Cars.

MSA Championship Permit No: 45/2012 has been issued.

The Summer Challenge will run to the same regulations and technical regulations as the Endurance Road Rally Championship except where modified as follows.

4 DRIVER/NAVIGATOR

4.1. On events where cars can be double driven a navigator may also enter as a driver and vice versa. In such a case the points will be based on the best position achieved by each crew member, regardless of whether they drive or navigate. There will be no distinction between drivers and navigators for the challenge i.e. there will be one championship table only.

5 CLASSES

5.1. The Summer Challenge will be made up of 3 classes.

Expert

Semi Expert

Novice

These will be based on section 5.2, 5.3 and 5.4 in the Endurance Road Rally Championship regulations.

6 POINTS

6.1. Points will be allocated based on class position from among registered championship contenders only.

6.2. 1st in class 10 points

2nd in class 9 points

Down to 9th in class 2 points all other finishers 1 point.

If there are less than 5 starters in the class then the points will be reduced by 1 point per start under 5. i.e. 4 starters 1st in class will get 9 points, 3 starters 1st in class will get 8 points etc.

6.4. Ties for 1st overall will not be resolved and the prize of a paid entry on the Exmoor Endurance Rally will be split. i.e. if there are two winners, each will get ½ their entry paid for the event. Ties for other positions will be resolved by reference to the highest score in an individual event.

7 AWARDS

7.1 Overall awards

1st overall will receive a paid entry on the 2011 Exmoor Endurance Rally.

This award cannot be won by a past winner of the Endurance championship. No cash alternative will be given. In the event that a past ERRC winner scores the most points, the award will be given to the highest scoring competitor who is not a past winner.

Class awards

1st in each class

A contender must take start in 2 rounds to win an award.

8 CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS

8.1. The challenge will be made up of 4 events. These events may be changed up to one month before the first round. Notice will be given by email to the address submitted with the registration and published on the website.

8.2. The awards will be decided on the contender's best 3 scores.

TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

A.15 WHEELS & TYRES

Competitors are free to use any tyre that complies with the individual events regulations unless the event is run under an Endurance Road Rally Permit in which case A.15 applies.
